MSBL WS Manager Profile Vince Overfelt (70+ Paladin)

I spoke with longtime MSBL WS manager, Vince Overfelt and here's what he had to say. I manage and play for Paladin USA Baseball in the 65+ and 70+ divisions. We play in the sandbaggers division since we've not won a ring. But when we do, we will move up without any excuses. I've been playing in the MSBL World Series since 1998, initially with a 35+ team from where I live and played, Albuquerque, New Mexico. Once I played in my first World Series, I was locked in for the long run. I've been involved in MSBL since 1996 and recently retired two years ago from being the president of the New Mexico MABL/MSBL local league. I left it in the great hands of Bryan DeShayes and Matt Reeder. I got involved with the local league at the age of 48 after playing softball since leaving NMSU. I thought I was too old then, but then the bug bit me, and I'm still playing baseball. I won a ring in 2003 with the Phoenix 50's in the 48 division, with props to Wally Kopp and Chuck Brockman, whose teams I originally played for in the 50+ divisions.



In 2007, I finally put my Paladin USA team together and played good enough to win the 55+ American Division ring. (Whatever happened to the American division?) Again, with help from Chuck and Wally, we made the finals a time or two but finished second. We have won the Kickoff Classic and Las Vegas Open several times, and a couple of San Diego Memorial Day tournaments. That is a great tourney and a very entertaining time. Off the diamond, I have two daughters and four grandchildren. Louie, the oldest, is 13 and one of the best 13-year-old baseball players in Albuquerque. He's a lefty that can bring it at 70+ mph! He also possesses a *BIG* bat. Henry is an upcoming soccer stud (8 years old). And Jack, who is four, will become the second coming of Louie very soon. These guys are my oldest daughter Crystal's kids. My youngest daughter, Sara, has a 19-month-old daughter and a future soccer player in 8-10 years. 50+ Division Pool Play Games Wrap Up Today / 25+ Teams Begin Play Both Teams Need To Exchange Complete Rosters 30 Minutes Before the Game

For a couple 50+ teams, the playoffs start today. It's a good position to be in when your fate is in your control. Win the game and play tomorrow. Lose the game and schedule a tee time for Thursday. That's really what it comes down to for a handful of teams. Another factor is going to be runs allowed. But if the team has already given up a bunch of runs, relying on the fewest runs allowed category as a tie breaker might not be a very good option.

Before every game, both team managers need to exchange complete team rosters, which includes first and last names, along with jersey numbers for every player. In addition to the starting lineup, all of the sub players need to be listed. And if your playing in a participation division, it's really important to let the other team manager know how many dressed players the team has for that game. For example, if your roster lists 17 players, but only 12 show up for the game, then you won't be getting 14 players an at bat. It's imperative that information is shared with the opposing manager, giving him the opportunity to bat 12 players as well.

Every player is required to have a current, government issued - photo ID with them during games. If there's an issue in which a team questions another players age, the ID is necessary to show verification. This process shouldn't take more than 5 minutes. However, waiting until the game is over, to request a player's ID is not a smart move. Player's who can't come up with a photo ID, will not be allowed to continue playing.

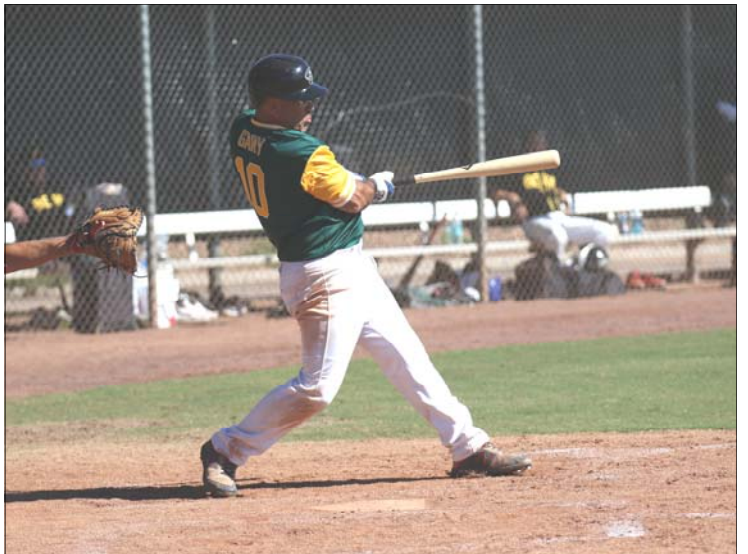
